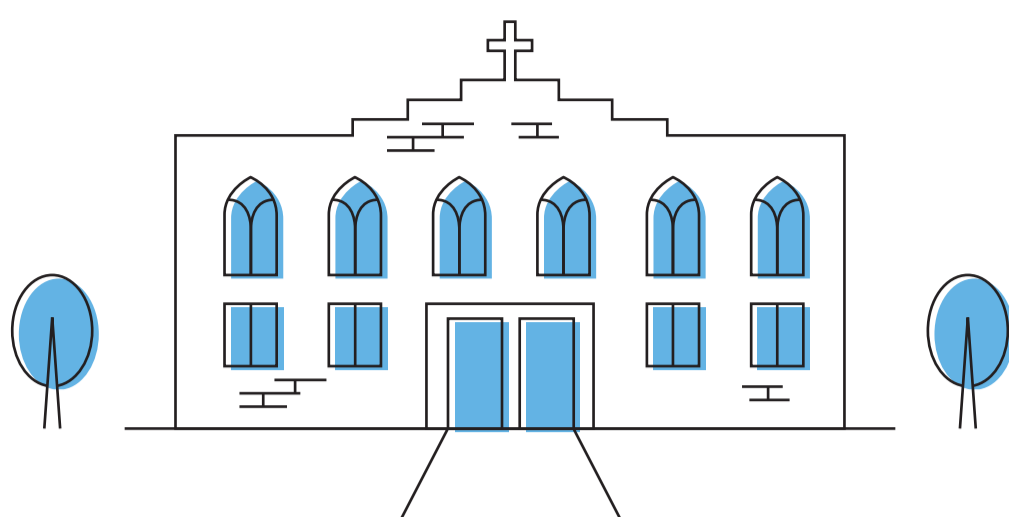

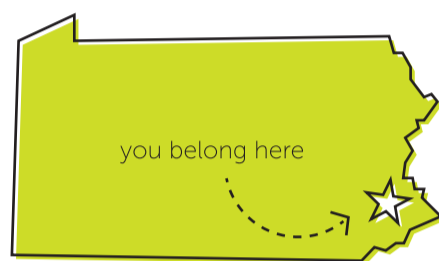

## Low Cost, High Value

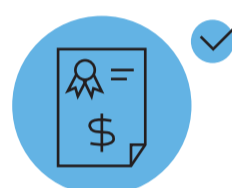

# 96%

Close to **96%** of our students qualify for a variety of scholarships, and / or student financial aid, making us an even more compelling value.



# 50%

The rate of graduation or transfer of our students to a four-year school within three years is nearly **50%** higher than our peer schools.



# \$16,429

The cost of tuition per semester is **\$8,214.50**. Per year, tuition is \$16,429. Each semester consists of 12-18 credit-hours.

# \$17,299

For Allied Health students, the cost of tuition is **\$8,599.50** per semester. Per year, tuition is \$17,299.

# 9:1
