


MANOR COLLEGE ACCUPLACER EXEMPTION POLICIES

The student who has earned a Bachelor degree.			
The student who has earned an Associate Degree from Manor College.			
The student who has earned an Associate Degree within 10 years of acceptance into Manor from a college other than Manor College.			
The student who has scored above 530 or above on SAT mathematics.		The student who has scored 530 or above on SAT Critical Reading.	
The student who has scored 22 or above in ACT math.		The student who has scored 21 or above in ACT reading.	
Dual Enrollment students who have earned Manor credit in college level mathematics.		Dual Enrollment students who have earned Manor credit for EN101.	
The student who has transferred MH103 or equivalent from another institution.		The student who has transferred EN101 and/or EN102 from another institution.	
		The student who has earned a 2.6 GPA in high school and has earned a grade of C or better in each high school English classes.	
		The student who has earned six or more college-level credits, with a C or better.	

The student who has taken any of the required Accuplacer Sub-Tests for the current academic year at another accredited college or university, in a proctored setting, may choose to have the Official Accuplacer Score Report sent to Manor College in lieu of taking the Accuplacer tests at Manor College.

A student may retake each subtest only once. There is a \$25.00 fee to retest for one or more of the four tests.
