

Dual Enrollment students who have earned Manor credit for Statistics.		Dual Enrollment students who have earned Manor credit for EN101.	
The student who has transferred a mathematics course in Statistics from another institution.		The student who has transferred EN101 and/or EN102 from another institution.	

The student who has taken any of the required Accuplacer Sub-Tests for the current academic year at another accredited college or university, in a proctored setting, may choose to have the Official Accuplacer Score Report sent to Manor College in lieu of taking the Accuplacer tests at Manor College.

A student may retake each subtest only once. There is a \$25.00 fee to retest for one or more of the four tests.

Placement testing is waived for applicants whose SAT or ACT scores exceed the minimum program requirements.
