

Adjunct Faculty – Biological Sciences I (BI 101) Manor College – Division of Science & Mathematics

Position Overview

Manor College invites applications for an Adjunct Faculty position to teach BI 101: Biological Sciences I, a foundational course for science majors. This course provides a comprehensive study of the fundamental concepts of living organisms, with emphasis on the molecular and cellular organization of life. The laboratory component is designed to reinforce lecture topics through hands-on investigation and experimentation.

Course Description

BI 101 introduces students to the basic unit of life, the cell, and explores:

- Cell structure and function, including reproduction
- Basic biochemistry
- Energy in biological systems
- Genetics and gene expression
- The scientific method and principles of evolution

Laboratory investigations include comparisons of the three Domains of life, cellular processes, molecular biology, and genetics. The course consists of three (3) hours of lecture and two (2) hours of laboratory per week.

Responsibilities

- Teaches lecture and laboratory sessions in alignment with the course description and learning outcomes
- Develops and delivers engaging instructional materials that support student success
- Assessments of student performance through assignments, exams, and lab work
- Maintains accurate records of student progress and grades

- Fosters an inclusive, supportive learning environment consistent with Manor College's mission
- All other duties as assigned

Qualifications

- Master's degree or higher in Biology, Biochemistry, or a closely related field (required)
- Prior teaching experience at the college level preferred
- Strong commitment to student-centered teaching and academic excellence
- Ability to integrate laboratory and lecture content effectively
