It involves assisting in one or more of the labs held on Tuesday afternoon, Thursday afternoon and Friday morning throughout the entire semester. Each lab is 2 hours long. The position is responsible for supporting the students in a simulated clinical environment and ensuring the wellbeing of the live animals. This position reports directly to the Small Animal Clinical Coordinator.

- Works closely with students during 2-hour laboratory sessions to help them learn and refine essential clinical and emergency skills, including:
 - Placing IV catheters
 - Phlebotomy
 - Administering medications
 - Fluid therapy
 - Cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- Demonstrates professionalism, knowledge and a strong commitment to supporting student learning
