- Active Pennsylvania Certified Registered Nurse Practitioner (CRNP) license with prescriptive authority.
- Must maintain all professional licenses, certifications, and insurance necessary to perform services as an independent contractor.
- Successful completion of all required pre-engagement background checks, including criminal history and any other legally required clearances, is required as a condition of appointment.
- Current CPR/AED certification and other certifications required by law.
- Professional liability (malpractice) insurance.
- Experience providing primary healthcare services.
